

7/07 VACANCY ON BOARD. The Board member position of **CERTIFIED RESIDENTIAL APPRAISER** has just become vacant on the Board. In addition, two **PUBLIC MEMBER** positions are also available. To apply to fill a vacant position, go to www.governor.state.az.us and click on Boards and Commissions. The Arizona Board of Appraisal consists of nine members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. Four members are appraisers: one licensed; one certified residential; one certified general; and one licensed or certified. Three members are public with no personal or business appraisal relationship. One member is a registered property tax agent. One member is a public member employed by a lending institution (cannot be an appraiser). No more than two appraisers from the same appraisal association or organization can serve concurrently. Members serve staggered terms of three years and cannot serve more than two consecutive terms of their own.
